SOME RULES:

- Movies must be rated no higher than "G" or "PG"
- Games in Knox Hall must be rated no higher than "E" or "E+10"
- Games in Venture room must be rated no higher than "E" or "E+10" or "T"
- Scouts are not allowed in the following areas: sanctuary, basement, office, pre-school wing, room 211 parlor (adult quiet room), room 206 library, storage rooms & closets, east stairway.
- The elevator is off-limits to youth unless accompanied by an adult.
- Food and drink are allowed only in the tiled areas of the Fellowship Hall. Only water is allowed in the carpeted areas, including the second-floor classrooms and Narthex (main entrance area).
- There will be no Wi-Fi or internet available (The church has very low band width & it is not practical). Scouts may use their own data on their phones and may set up Hot Spots if available.
- The narthex will be for adults only.

LIGHT UP THE GRAND INFORMATION

- Illumination is REQUIRED: All floats, walkers, cars, and motorized vehicles must include lights. Walkers are highly encouraged to use glow sticks or battery-operated lights.
- Drop Off Location: Village Commons Plaza (32732 Grand River Ave, Farmington -Sidecar Slider Bar, Mazzoni Jewelers, and Edible Arrangements strip-mall.). There is NO PARKING for parade participants in the Village Commons Plaza parking lot – Drop Off only. Have Scouts look for us at the back (North end) of the parking lot for our Tail Gate Party.
- The Parade begins at 5:00 pm. It is a 0.6 mile/14-minute walk from Village Commons Plaza to Governor Warner Mansion.
- The parade ends at Governor Warner Mansion. There are activities at the Governor Werner Mansion, stay as long as you like,
- Parents are encouraged to plan a pick-up point away from the main route to avoid congestion.
